Important information you need to know for the Alpine Bank Boulder Thanksgiving Day race on Thursday November 23rd.

WHERE

Flatiron Park 2209 Central Ave, Boulder 80301

RACE NUMBER AND T-SHIRT PICK UP - (T-Shirt must have been ordered before 11/1/2023).


Option 1 - DAY BEFORE RACE:

11am - 4pm on Wednesday, November 22nd from Runners Roost Boulder (629 S Broadway, Suite E, Boulder, 80305)

Option 2 - RACE DAY:

From **8:00am** on Thursday November 23rd at the "Troop Events Athlete Management" Canopy near the race finish line at 2209 Central Ave, Boulder 80301.

*You **MUST** pick up your race number no later than **20mins** before your scheduled race time start. Please realize that the race start line is roughly 400m away from race number pick up area!



RACE START TIMES

9:00am Kids 12 years and under - 1K

9:15am Open - 5K

RACE COURSE

The race start line will be on Central Ave, just down from Upslope Brewing Company at 1898 S Flatiron Ct, Boulder, 80301. The race finish line will be by Wild Provisions Beer Project at 2209 Central Ave, Boulder 80301.

ROAD CLOSURES

Please note you CANNOT drive into Flatiron Park. There are road closures on Central Ave and Flatiron Pkwy from 55th St.

RACE NUMBER

Please make sure that your race number is affixed to the front of your shirt, and it is clearly visible.

RACE BRIEFING

There will be a call for all runners to be at the start line roughly 5mins before the start of their respective race.

CLOTHING

Please make sure you have adequate attire for the event. The weather forecast is currently predicted with a low of 26F and a high of 43F.

BAD WEATHER

In the unlikely event that we have bad weather such as lighting, a decision will be made whether the event will be delayed or stopped. Your safety is paramount, and the weather can turn bad very quickly!

TOIL FTS

There will be 8 Porta-lets in the parking lot of 2209 Central Ave, near the race finish line.

FIRST AID

Chris Wentz from Event Medical Specialists, LLC will be on-site as our EMT and to provide our First Aid and Medical.

KIDS 1K RACE FOR 12 YEARS AND UNDER

A parent may run or walk with their child who is under 6 years of age in the Kids 1K race **FREE** of charge, but they must start at the back of the field.

TIMING

All races will be electronically timed by Runners Roost Race Services.

MUSIC

We will have live entertainment from DJ Chris Cockroft (www.tiptopdj.com).

HEADPHONES

Headphones are allowed but please make sure you are aware of your surroundings and always listening to important information that could be coming from one of our marshals or volunteers. Again, your safety is important to us.

RACE EVENT SPECTATORS

All spectators must stay off the road.

RACE START/ FINISH AREA

Only those that are racing, are permitted around the start/ finish line area. This area must be kept clear at all times to help for timing and marshalling race participants.

NO ANIMALS ALLOWED

There are **NO** dogs allowed in the race.

STROLLERS

Anyone wanting to run with a stroller may do so, but you must start at the very back of the field.

VOLUNTEERS/ MARSHALS

15 - 20 volunteers have given up their time to help make this event possible. Please show your appreciation by being courteous at all times and please adhere to any information they may be trying to give you.
